Core - Basic Pesticide: This 2-hour course review current laws and regulations affecting applicators and inspectors and pesticide handling and safety.

This 4 hour course reinforces construction design principles and structural concerns and how these insects affect them. Also included is a review of chemical and non-chemical treatment systems and their effectiveness in controlling and eradicating these insects so the questions posed by clients can be answered. A discussion of new trends and laws affecting this profession are included.

Category 7B – Proper Inspection and Reporting Techniques for Termites & Other Wood Destroying Insects: This 4-hour course is designed to teach inspectors how to identify and distinguish the difference between the most common types of wood destroying insects and wood destroying organisms. The course will enhance your inspection abilities in the inspection process and how to write a proper report. There will also be a discussion of the latest trends in inspection tools such as infrared technology and boroscopes.
